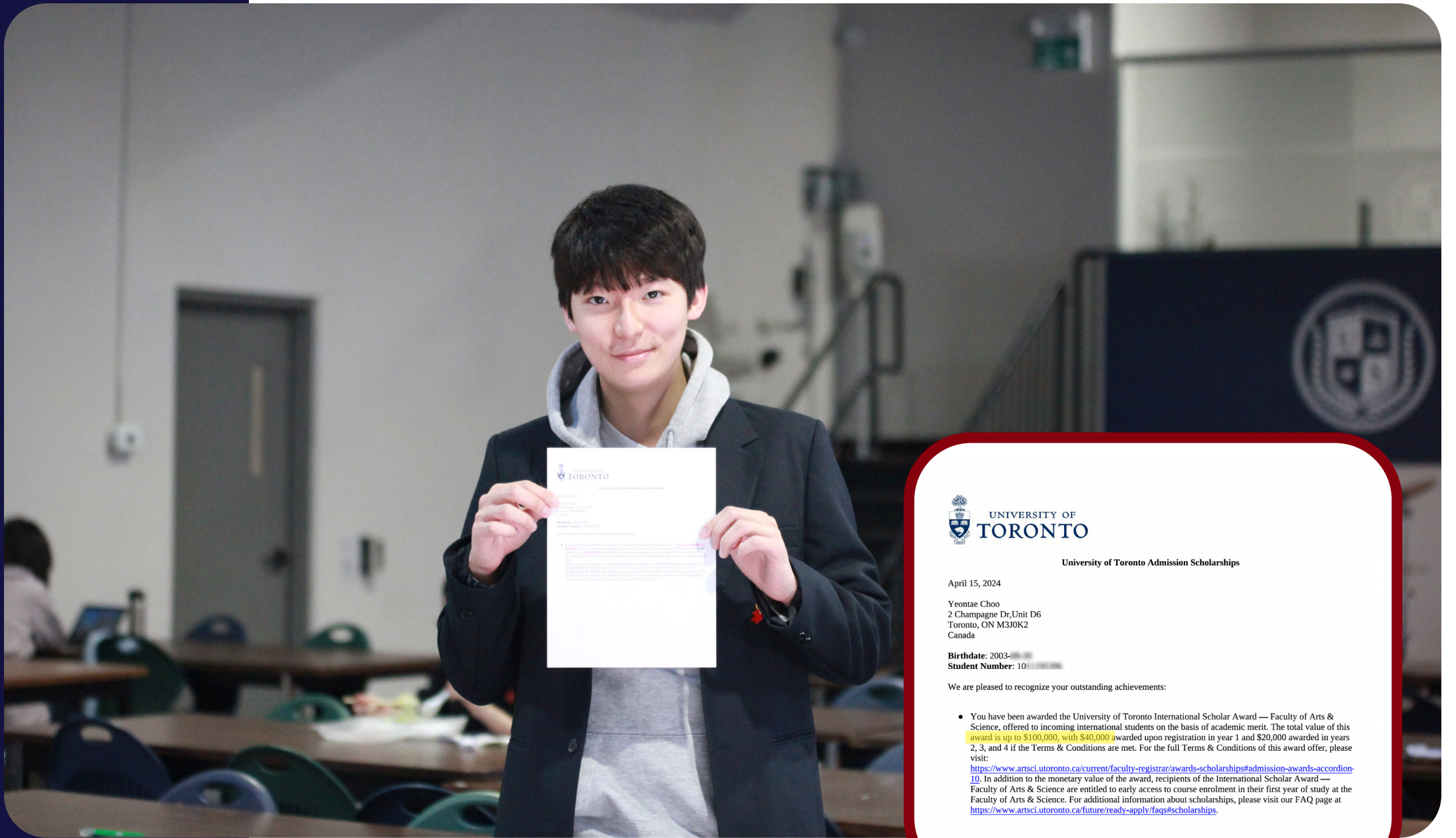

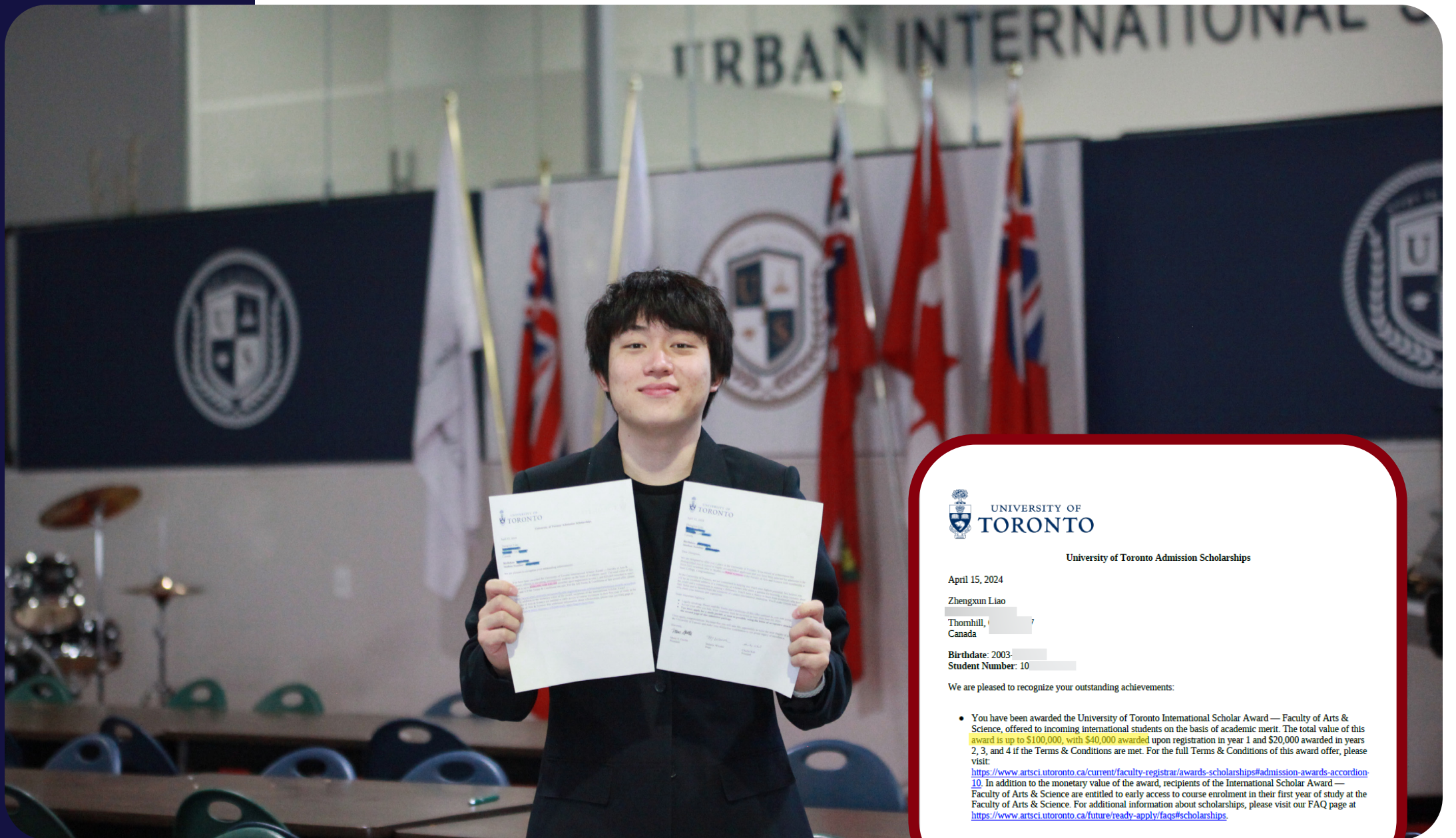

UIS Science Fair 2024

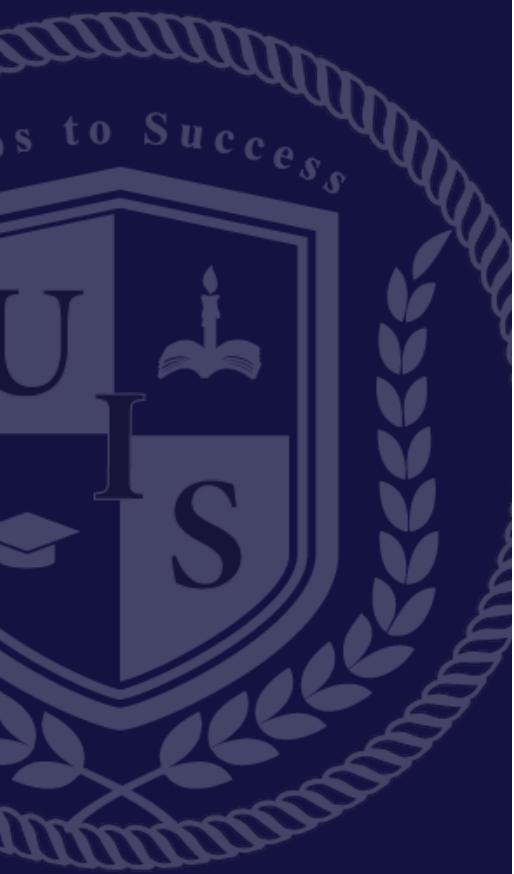
